These data were not available at the time of the publication of the July 1, 1961 semi-annual report. Figures reported previously were: State of Hawaii - 611,544, County of Honolulu - 480,524, City of Honolulu - 307,181, and balance of Honolulu County - 173,343.

Estimates of civilian population of the State of Hawaii were prepared according to the migration-natural increase method. The method is based on the April 1, 1960 U.S. Census of civilian population, less residents temporarily absent from Hawaii, plus visitors present in the area. Data on civilian migration in and out of the State of Hawaii were provided by each air and surface carrier. Data on migration between islands were provided by the Hawaii Aeronautics Commission. Data on net movement of civilians in and out of the Armed Forces were obtained from the personnel center of each service. Data on births and deaths were obtained from the Research, Planning and Statistics Office.

These estimates (de facto) include civilians actually present in the area on the date indicated. They include all dependents (61,977) of military personnel and an undetermined number of visitors present, but do not include military personnel. There were 59,487 servicemen in Hawaii on January 1, 1962 who were excluded from the estimates given above.
